
## Our Ministries

The Sisters of St. Francis of Penance and Christian Charity is an international congregation founded in 1835 in the Netherlands by Mother Magdalen Damen.

Mother Magdalen Damen carried the Franciscan charism of simplicity and service into the world of her day. Her unshakeable trust in God led to a unity in her life of prayer and service.

Called by God's goodness, the **Sisters of St. Francis** profess to live the gospel life, following the teachings of Jesus Christ vowing obedience, poverty, and chastity.

- Like Francis of Assisi and Magdalen Damen, we trust God's goodness, living the gospel in our time with gentle courtesy toward all creation.
- In 1874, the first missionary sisters arrived in Buffalo, New York. They brought the Franciscan charism of simplicity and service to the United States. The sisters continue to spread the good news ~ striving to become a sign of hope to a struggling world.

**Associates** are men and women, married or single, from different backgrounds and walks of life. They believe that through a non-vowed relationship with the sisters, they can live a deeper response to the gospel way of life.
